

### Example 7: Adding Graphics to the PNR/Booking File Display


The files and/or techniques in Method A are not [version controlled](#). The files and/or techniques in Method B are [version controlled](#).

This example demonstrates two methods for adding new graphics to customize the [PNR/Booking File](#) display in Viewpoint™.

- In [Method A](#), new graphics are added directly to pnr.html, which implements the PNR/Booking File display. However, this file is NOT version controlled, and any subsequent installations of Viewpoint will discard customizations made to pnr.html.
- In [Method B](#), new graphics are added to pnr\_custom\_top.html, which displays above the PNR/Booking File data in the main display. This HTML file is version controlled, and will not be over-written by subsequent installations.

### Customization Scenario

Both methods for adding the graphic create a similar result.

- A graphic file, , is added above the PNR/Booking File data in the main PNR/Booking File display.
- When the user clicks the graphic, a custom message box displays.

**Note:** This example shows an animated GIF. However, it should be noted that excessive use of animated graphics is not typically recommended.

### Customization Techniques

This example uses the following techniques for customization:

- Inserting graphics into the PNR/Booking File display.
- Using customizable HTML files.
